Camper Instructions

1. All campers will be signed in and out of camp by their parent or guardian. Anyone, other than the parent or guardian, bringing or picking up a camper must be listed on the Health and Safety Information form and will be required to present picture ID.
2. Campers should wear comfortable, enclosed shoes (no flip flops or sandals). Long sleeves and pants are recommended.
3. All campers must bring a sack lunch with their name on the front. Lunches will be refrigerated.
4. All campers will receive two snacks and water each day. Campers may not bring extra treats or snacks.
5. Cell phone usage will not be allowed in the classroom.
6. All campers will be expected to stay for the entire day camp.
7. All campers need to be delivered to the site no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and picked up no later than 4:15 p.m. If there is an emergency prior to 8:45 a.m. please call 661.323.8353 ext. 13 or 14.
8. There are no refunds for anyone not completing the entire camp session.
9. Please be sure that anyone listed as an emergency contact for your camper knows they are on this list and is available to pick up your youngster in case of an emergency.
10. Bad behavior will not be tolerated. Campers who are disruptive during the day camp will be asked to go home.
